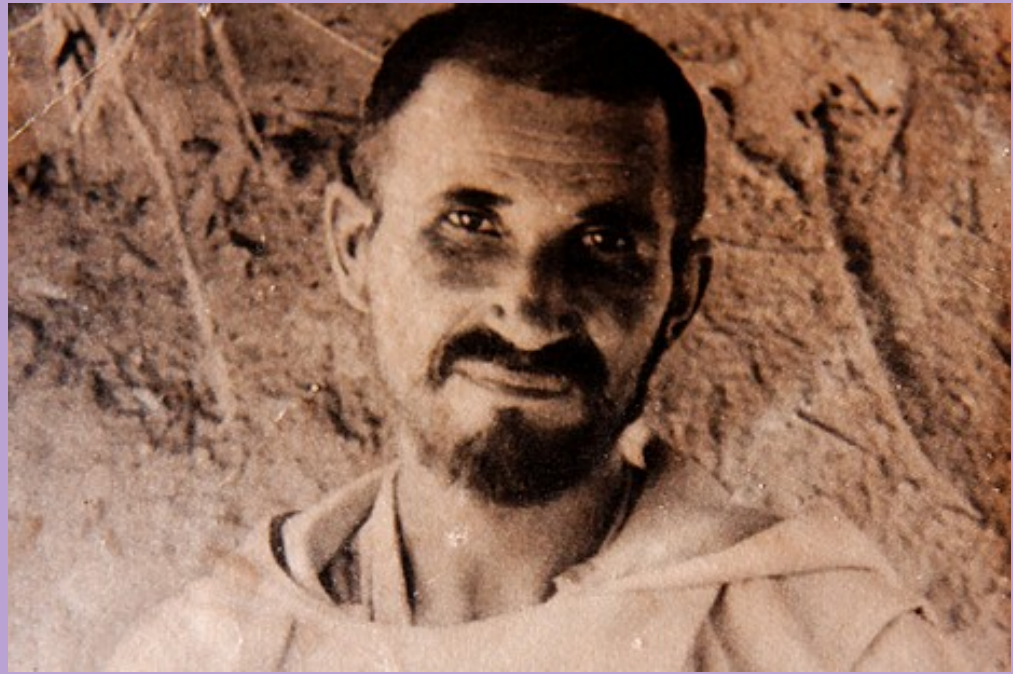

Col 1:24

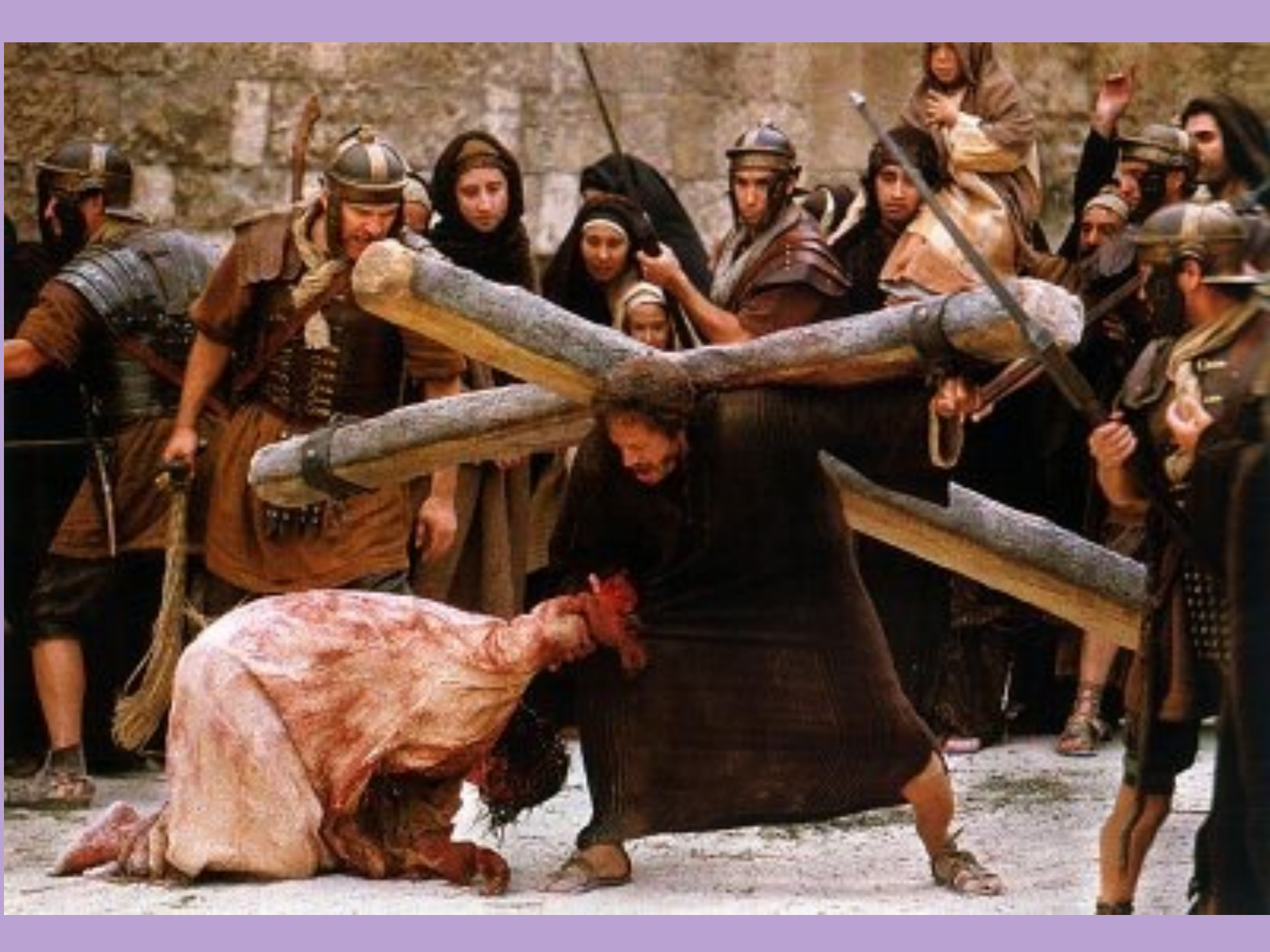
For to me, living is Christ and dying is gain. Phil 1:21
